Readings: Genesis 18:1-10; Psalm 14; Paul 1:24-28; Luke 10:38-42

Psalm Response: The just will live in the presence of the Lord.

REFLECTION ON THE READINGS

Stories of hospitality feature today. Abraham's welcome to his mystery visitors is followed by Martha and Mary's hosting of Jesus. Hospitality is such a prominent theme in the gospel of Luke that scripture scholar Brendan Byrne named his commentary on it *The Hospitality of God*. He explains why:

"Even a casual reading of Luke makes clear how often in this gospel significant events and exchanges take place in the context of meals and the offering (or non offering) of hospitality in general."

"But there is more to it than that. Luke sees the whole life and ministry of Jesus as a visitation on God's part to Israel and the world... The crucial point is that those who do receive him find that he brings them into a much wider sphere of hospitality: the 'hospitality of God'. The One who comes as a visitor and guest in fact becomes *host* and offers hospitality in which human beings and, potentially the entire world can become truly human, be at home, *know* salvation in the depths of their hearts" (Sydney: St Paul's 2015, 8). That's really good news.
